## Placement of urinary bladder cathether

## General rules

- 1. Every placement of urinary bladder cathether should be medically indicated
- 2. The patient should be provided with intimate conditions
- 3. The patient should be informed about the procedure and obtained consent should be taken
- 4. The procedure should be performed using aseptic technique

## Procedure of Foley insertion

\*the procedure is performed by one person with a prepared sterile table with equipement

- 1. Introduce yourself
- 2. Explain the procedure to the patient
- 3. Obtain patient consent
- 4. Wash and desinfect your hands
- 5. Wear sterile gloves
- 6. Attach the urine drainage bag
- 7. Place sterile drape
- 8. Desinfect catherisation area
- 9. Place sterile lubricant on Foley cathether
- 10. Place sterile lubricant into the urethra

## Procedure of Foley insertion

- 11. Wait 3 minutes until lidocaine start to work
- 12. Hold the cathether with the dominant hand
- 13. Insert the cathether into the bladder to the bifurcation
- 14. Check the urine flow
- 15. Inflate the retention baloon with the volume indicated on the catheter
- 16. Gently pull back on the catheter until resistance is met to place it correctly
- 17. Place the drianage bad on the side of the patients bed
- 18. Take off the gloves and place them in medical waste container
- 19. Wash and desinfect your hands
