Detailed notes on the course of the stations:

- 1. The same simulators on which students practice in SimCenter (adult, child, infant/newborn) will be used for the OSCE station.
- 2. You should ask Big Brother for aspects of the physical examination that cannot be examined on the simulator (examples: skin colour, oedema, neurological examination, internal organs of the abdominal cavity, etc.). Simulator tremors / convulsions look the same regardless of their characteristics or cause (the simulator "can't" vibrate otherwise).
- 3. During the station (as opposed to the simulation scenarios in paediatrics and internal medicine) it is not obligatory to remove the medicine package and draw it into the syringe.
- 4. The form and method of administration of the medicine are mandatory.
- 5. During the station, the student must report loudly what he is doing, including the tests he orders, consultations, prescriptions and diagnosis. This is necessary for the proper evaluation of a given station.
- 6. The student will receive all the necessary tests results / consultations after ordering them. If any tests or consultations are not needed to complete the station, the student will be informed that they will be available in an hour.
- 7. During the station we do not fill in any personal data (e.g. name, surname, etc.),
- 8. On the prescription, we write only the name of the medicine (international or commercial) and the form. We do not write refunds, government numbers, etc.
- 9. Information about the decision on qualification for vaccination is announced loudly at the end of the station with the words "I qualify or not for vaccination against . . . "
- 10. The equipment available in the room depends on the specifics of the scenario and is sufficient to complete the task. If a student has any doubts, he/ she can address the Big Brother.
- 11. During the station, additional help should not be expected, if a team member is necessary to complete the task, the student will be informed about it before entering the room.
- 12. At the "glucose measurement" station, the entire measurement procedure should be carried out; only the finger prick of the simulator should be simulated. During other stations, you can ask Big Brother about the blood glucose result.
- 13. Please remember to be safe when using the defibrillator.
- 14. Technical problems will never be an obstacle to completing the station, if you are not sure what you have found, you can ask Big Brother.
